Ask yourself ...

-Can they follow simple, 2-step commands? (e.g., go to your room and get your shoes) -Are they continuing to produce new words and combine 3-4 words in phrases? -Are they producing early developing sounds consistently? (/p, b, m/)

-Can both you and others understand them between 50-75% of the time?

-Can they answer simple "what, where" questions?



2 - 3 year Milestones

Expressive Language: Receptive Language: -Combines 3-4 words -Understands "wh" -Answers "wh" questions auestions -Uses possession -Follows 2 step -Uses adverbs (here, commands -Knows descriptive now) -Uses "is" concepts (short, tall, big -Uses variety of small) grammatical endings -Understands pronouns Pragmatic Language: Speech Sound Development: -Watches other children and briefly joins in play -Requests permission /p, b, m, h, n, w, b, k, g, d/ -Uses language for jokes and teasing -Makes conversational repairs when listener doesn't understand -Plays house Speech Sound -Participates in simple group activities Intelligibility -Participates in simple make believe activities -Holds up fingers to tell age 50-75% Intelligible to -Looks for missing toys both familiar and nonfamiliar listeners
